WELCOME TO READING!

★ Head to **Caversham** for Tesco Express, Waitrose, Costa Coffee and the Alto Lounge café bar.

★ Head to the **Town Centre** for McDonald's, clothes, camping supplies and anything else. Find a cheap meal at Wetherspoons or buy a warm jumper from Primark for the cold nights. The Oracle Shopping Centre has all the main clothing retailers, HMV, and a large Boots. Broad Street has WHSmith, Sainsburys, coffee shops and various useful shops. There is a camping shop (Blacks) on Chain St. The Harris Arcade (off Friar Street) houses a few independent outlets selling records, comics and vintage clothing, amongst other things.

★ Head to **Oxford Road** for McDonald's (near Reading West Train Station), Tesco (entrance Oxford Rd or Portman Rd for cars), Domino's Pizza, Music Man (2nd hand instruments and records), Workhouse Coffee, takeaways. Free cash machine at Tesco Express.

★ **Parking** - Please follow colour coded Reading Festival signs.

★ Shuttle Buses

It is an approx. 15min walk to the festival entrance, and normally £1 on the shuttle bus from Reading Station North, ND stop (take the underpass if coming from the south side), running Wed-Mon. Check www.reading-buses.co.uk for updates. Shuttle buses travel between Sainsbury's on Friar Street and the festival (from Rivermead Leisure Complex car park).
